Jazz and quilts are a perfect combination. Quilts swinging from the trees provide a perfect backdrop for local jazz artists.



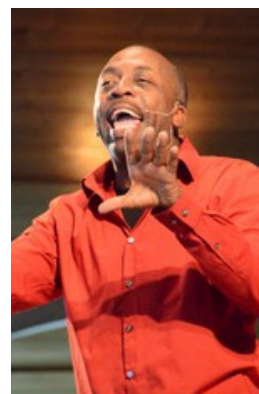
Opportunity Drawing
