

### THIS WEEK--SUNDAY MORNING ADULT CLASS

Last week we began discussion of Brian McClaren's *Do I Stay Christian?: A Guide for the Doubters, the Disappointed, and the Disillusioned*. We reviewed McClaren's laundry list of things Christian's can't be proud of: anti-semitism that killed hundreds of thousands--or if we include the "Christian" Nazis, millions over 2000 years; the high death toll Christians inflicted on *other* Christians, Muslims and others during the Crusades and Inquisition; Christian leaders' historic alliance with power and money brokers in their exploitation of indigenous peoples; indifference or active participation in exploiting people of color and non-Western cultures; and for many, insisting on a stuck theology based on ancient thinking and actively ignoring the implications of the sciences, both physical and social. Then there's that thing about white male patriarchy. 'Nuff said.

*Fortunately*, after McClaren completes his "why people leave" list, he moves on to, "why many who are troubled by Christianity's downside choose to remain Christian. *That's* our conversation this week. Join us for our lively discussion in Room 6 this Sunday, March 12, at 9:45 a.m.
